Step 3: Fill out the registration information.

Pre-requisites and Course Schedule:

This course is open to active registered BSA volunteer adult leaders, BSA merit badge counselors, and **MATURE Scouts (Boy Scouts and Venturers) aged 16 and above**. Youth Protection training must be current.

Each candidate will receive, by email, a description of the pre-qualification exercises, a class schedule, and a BSA commitment form. On Friday morning, a gun-safety skills and abilities demonstration will be required of each instructor-candidate. Following successful completion of the Pre-quals the *NRA Basic Instructor Training (BIT) will begin*. It is important for each candidate to ensure they are familiar with the pre-quals and are able to complete them successfully. Failure to pass the pre-quals will mean the candidate cannot take the course. (BIT is mandatory unless you have had BIT within 2 years from the date of the course. Bring your credentials for confirmation.)

Successful completion of these courses will result in your obtaining certification as an NRA Basic Pistol Instructor. As an NRA Certified Instructor you will be able to conduct and supervise pistol for BSA Venture Crews or individual members *in conjunction with an on-site NRA Certified Range Safety Officer*.

This course offering will begin on Friday at 8:00 am and will end before dinner on Saturday. If anyone needs to come early on Thursday night to be on time, someone will be available at Camp Mack Morris to check you in. Each candidate must be on time and attend the entire course.

Cost: The cost is \$85.00 and includes all course materials, meals, firearms usage, ammunition, and housing at Camp Mack Morris. The cost of your NRA credentials is not included and must be obtained directly from the NRA Instructors Portal after successful course completion. Accommodations include beds with mattresses in cabins. Participants will need to bring sleeping bags or sheets/blankets, pillow, and toiletries.
