"UNIT CHECK-IN AND SET-UP

"NATIVE WINDS"

Check-in time is between 5:00pm and 8:00pm on Friday, March 29th at the W.Q.W*headquarters. Campsite locations will be assigned at Check-in, so please do not start setting up camp before this time or you may end up having to move.

Unit Leaders - You will need the following 3 documents at Check-in:

1. Attendance Roster by Den.
2. Medical Forms (A & B) 1 copy for WOW and 1 Copy for Unit at campsite. (Scouts & Adults).
3. Permission Slip for each Scout.

You will be advised of your Unit's campsite at check-in. Once you have unloaded your equipment, please move (ALL VEHICLES TO THE DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS). Only trailers that are part of the campsite, to be inspected can be in the campsite. Vehicles hooked to a trailer are the only ones allowed in the campsite.

* Points will be deducted from your score if any vehicles are left in the campsite area.

If you have Campers, Leaders, or Parents with special needs, you must contact the WOW Staff prior to Registration so arrangements can be made.

Lights out will be at 10:30pm on Friday night and 11:00pm on Saturday night. Lights out applies to all Scouts and siblings attending. We ask that any Adults(s) who are up beyond the "lights out" be courteous to surrounding camps as well as your own campers who are trying to sleep.

UNIT CHECK-OUT

Check-Out time will begin at 10:00am on Sunday, March 31st. When ready to Check-out, remove all gear and police all of your campsite and common areas. The WOW! Staff must do the final inspections before Units will receive patches.

Leaders Cracker Barrel

All registered Leaders required to attend.

All registered Leaders should plan to attend the Cracker Barrel Friday evening at 9:30 at the WOW headquarters to get information on any changes, last minute instructions and to review the procedures for the next day's events. At this time, we will go over the details for the weekend. All registered Leaders must be at the meeting. We will be serving meat, cheese, and crackers at the Cracker Barrel for Leaders only. Each Unit should have something at their campsite for Scouts, siblings, and un-registered adults.

Saturday activities.

- Each den will be assigned a schedule for the activity rotation. The classes themselves will last about 60 minutes; each with 10 minutes for walking and bathroom breaks between rotations. Morning events will last about 3 hours.
- The activities are all in good fun. Some Scouts (and Adults too) may not have experienced an Event like this.

Saturday campfire ceremony information.

Parents and families are urged to attend the Campfire ceremony Saturday evening. It is tentatively set to begin at 8:00. All Webelos and Bear dens should be ready with a den yell and a den skit. Please ensure that all flashlights, spotlights, etc. are turned off during this event: except in emergency. WOW staff will have all lighting and sound needed for the campfire program. All Scouts and Leaders should wear Class B uniform to the campfire ceremony. All skits must be approved by the WOW staff before the campfire.

Miscellaneous Information.

- RV's and campers are not allowed at Camp Dudley Kizer.
- On Sunday morning, all Scouts and Leaders are encouraged to attend the non-denominational Scout's own service. Reverence is an important part of Scouting and a great way to start a Sunday.
