This training is for Scouters and Scouts, age 14 and older, in the principles of Leave No Trace and Tread Lightly. It provides environmental theory and practical outdoor guidelines for minimum-impact front country and backcountry use. Graduates will earn national recognition as LNT and TL Trainers. Scouts will be prepared to serve in the LNT Trainer position in their Unit.

Although not required, it is highly recommended that all participants go through Trainer's EDGE prior to this course.
